

Wash

- Wash Brook**
- widen brook and aerate using boulder riffles
 - thin out woodland canopy
 - improve diversity especially for invertebrates
 - improve access via bridges and paths
 - provide ecological information
 - create a learning zone.
 - 7,800m²

- The Lake**
- dredge to removed decades of leaf litter
 - aerate water
 - create vegetated margins for spawning and feeding
 - repair lake edges and surrounding paths
 - works to islands including stabilisation of walls and thinning trees
 - install new safety shore /beach edge to lake perimeter.
 - provide ecological information
 - 11,700m²

Wood

- Lakeside Woodland**
- thin out trees to improve light for the lake
 - create clearings to allow natural regeneration of the understory
 - plant woodland flora including native bulbs
 - improve nesting opportunities for bats, birds and invertebrates
 - 10,900m²

Heath

- Heathland**
- create new heathland dominated by heathers and acid grasses
 - promote flora + fauna
 - manage to prevent self-setting trees
 - 21,000m²

- Wet Woodland**
- Use area to drain lake dredgings
 - improve habitat for increased biodiversity
 - improve access for management
 - 10,000m²

People

- Dolphin Centre**
- Carry out a grand refurbishment with full green credentials.
 - Improve the buildings usefulness
 - Support the community through learning new skills and support.

Cycle

- Encourage cycling**
- provide an extension to the strategic cycle route by providing a new link around the lake to the HS2 depot
 - waymark the city cycle network from the park
 - waymark cycle routes around the park, including to the ecological enhanced areas for learning, play and rest.
